Roundhay School held a Summer School during the first two weeks of the summer holidays, across ten days, commencing 26/07/2021 until 06/08/2021 for incoming Year 7 pupils.

Places Offered

A total of 309 places were offered, 20% of these places were for pupils eligible for Pupil Premium.

Places Delivered

A total of 215 pupil places were delivered, 20% of these places were for pupils eligible for Pupil Premium.
