1. Download and install the relevant app (*click on the relevant icon below*)

For **Windows**



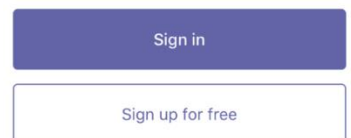

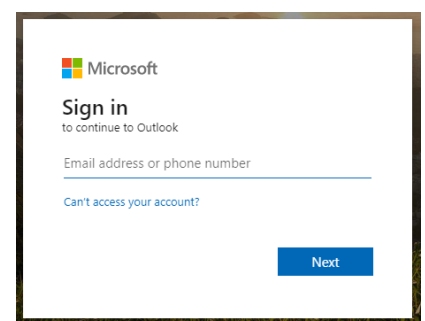
Logging on using a computer or laptop

1. Login to your school email at <https://outlook.office.com> using any web browser (e.g. Chrome, Internet Explorer, Safari).

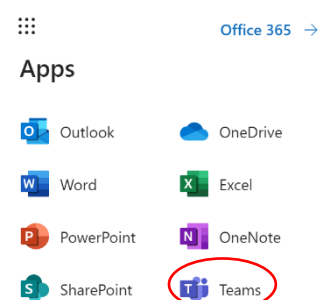

Your password is same as your computer password in school.



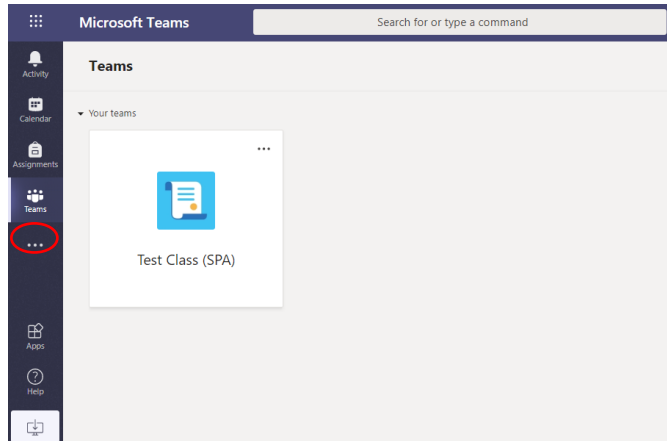
2. Click on this icon  in the top left hand corner of the email window.

3. Click on the Teams icon shown opposite.



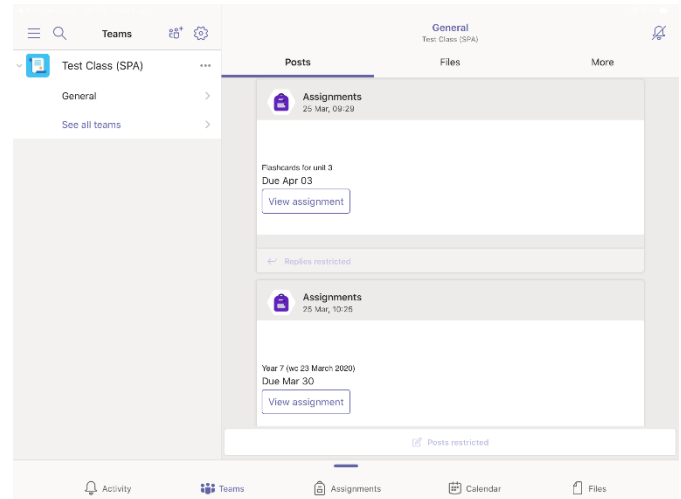
AN OVERVIEW






In a web browser icons are along the **left**



Clicking on the 3 dots reveals more options

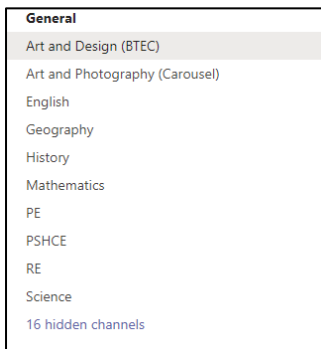
In an app icons may be along the **bottom**



 Teams	<p>Clicking here will show you all the Class Teams that you are a member of. Some may not appear if your class teacher has not yet activated the class.</p>
 Assignments	<p>Clicking here and selecting your class will shows you all the different assignments set by your teacher.</p>
 Activity	<p>Clicking here will show you a summary of the activity for the groups you are part of, including any assignments which your various teachers have set.</p>
 Calendar	<p>Clicking here will show you the calendar which is part of your school email account. It will usually show you your timetable for the week.</p>
 Files	<p>Clicking here gives you access to the Files from your OneDrive as well as any files your teachers have shared (by clicking on Microsoft Teams).</p>

YOUR TEAMS

Your list of Teams should include one for your year group.

In your year group team you will find a channel for each subject/qualification on the left hand side.

Some will appear automatically, but you can find the others by clicking on **hidden channels** at the bottom of the list. Click on a subject you study to add it to your default list. Some subjects will have multiple channels so check you select the one which matches the qualification you are studying.

At the top of the subject channel you will see some options.



Posts – a teacher may have posted instructions here

Files – this may contain files you need to complete your work

Notes – a teacher may have posted instructions here

If you are not in school you should find details of the work you need to complete within the subject/qualification channel of your year group team. You should:

- check the date the work was uploaded, read through the resource(s) and start working from the point you left off in class
- consider how much lesson time you would have had per week in a specific subject. This will help you to keep pace with those in school
- try to keep in touch with friends in school to find out how much the class has covered.

It does not matter if you get ahead - revisiting content and skills will help you remember it.

In addition to your year group channel you should also be a member of a class team for each of your subjects. If you cannot see a class please email logindetails@roundhayschool.com. Class Teams may also be used to set assignments and collect work (see page 5).

NOTIFICATION SETTINGS

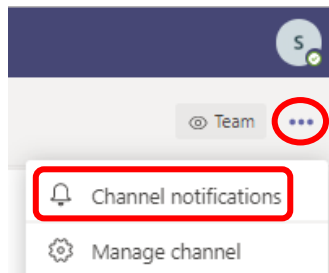
To make sure your activity feed alerts you when a teacher posts a message or assignment, you need to ensure your notification settings are correct for each class.

In the web browser or desktop app

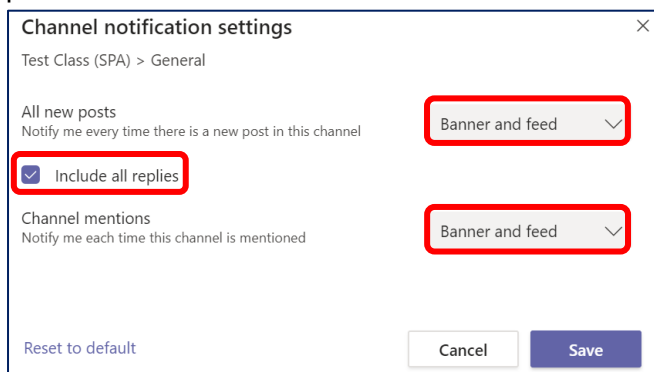
Click on Teams on the left hand side.

Click on a Class Team.

In the top right corner click on the three dots and choose Channel Notifications




Ensure notifications are turned on for all posts and click Save:



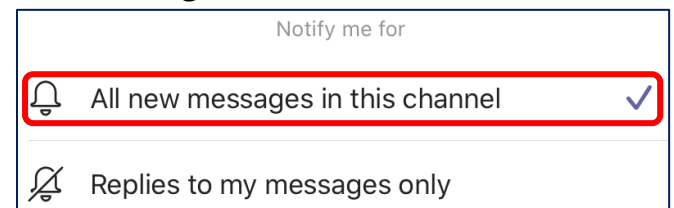
In the app for a smartphone or tablet

Click on Teams along the bottom.


Click on "General" under a Class Team.

Click on the  icon in the top left corner. *When it appears like this notification are on. When it has a line through it they are off.*

Ensure notifications are turned on for all new messages in the channel:



In the app you can also set *quiet hours* and *days* so you will not be disturbed:

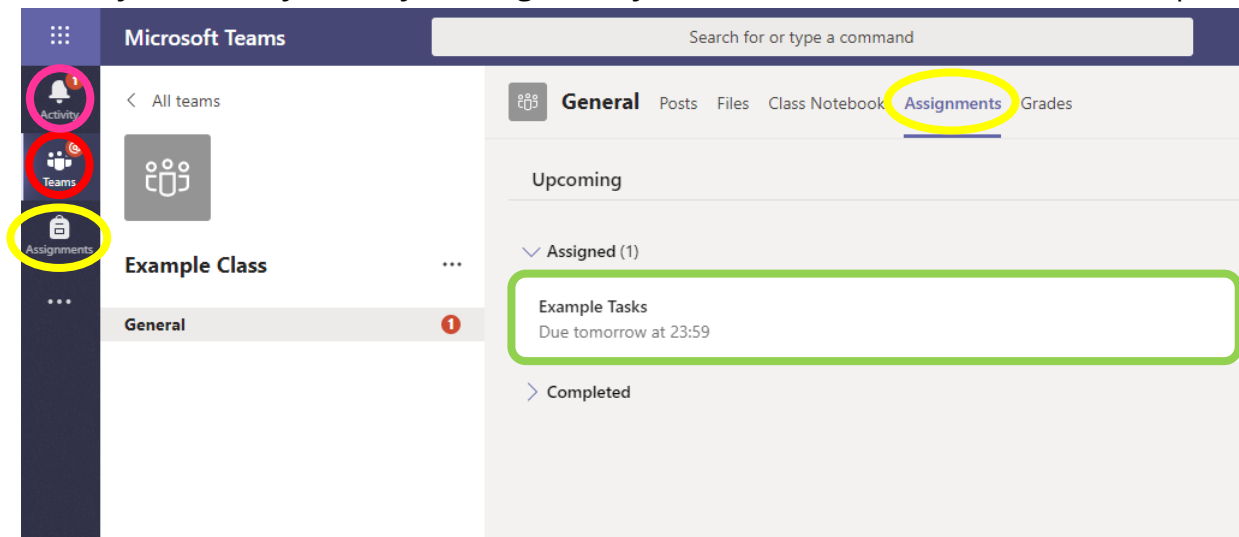
1. Click on the three lines  in the top left
2. Click on Notifications from the menu
3. Click on Quiet Hours from the top
4. Set the hours and/or days when you do not wish the app to show notifications
For example 17:00 to 09:00 each day.

Remember to set the notification settings for each team you belong to.

ASSIGNMENTS

Your teacher can set assignments for you to complete. You can access these by:

1. Click Assignments icon in the left or bottom menu (circled in red).
Select your class to see all the different assignments set by your teacher.
2. Click Teams icon in the left/bottom menu (circled in yellow).
Click on the relevant class (or on the word General underneath it in the app).
Click the Assignments tab (in the app this maybe under More).
3. Check your activity feed by clicking Activity in the left/bottom menu (circled in pink)



Clicking on an assignment (circled in green) will show you the task set.

Clicking on the link provided will take you to the quiz.

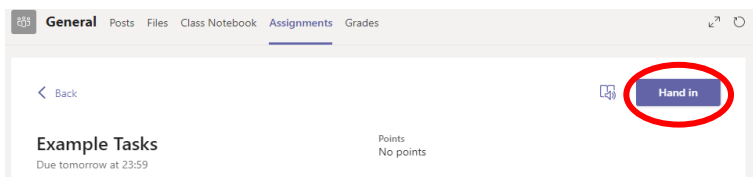
Work your way through the questions and pages, clicking Next or Submit as needed.

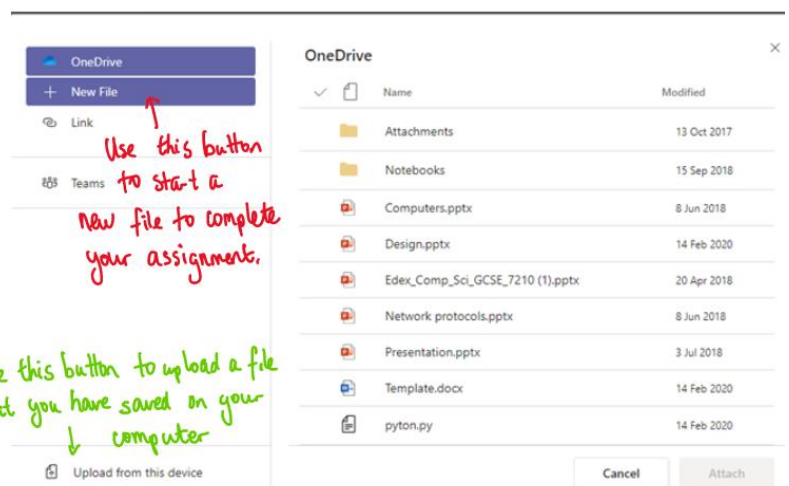

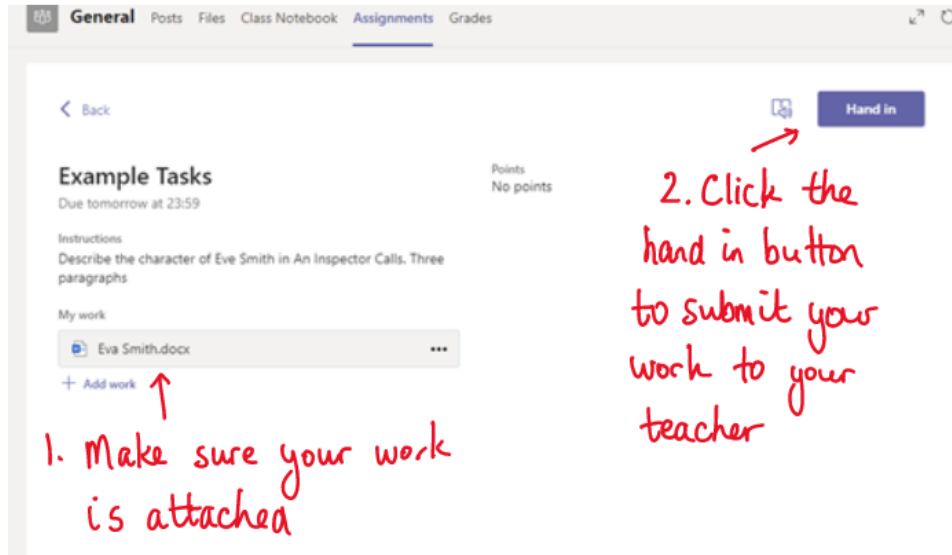
4. Uploading work that has been done on your computer

Click on **+ Add work**.

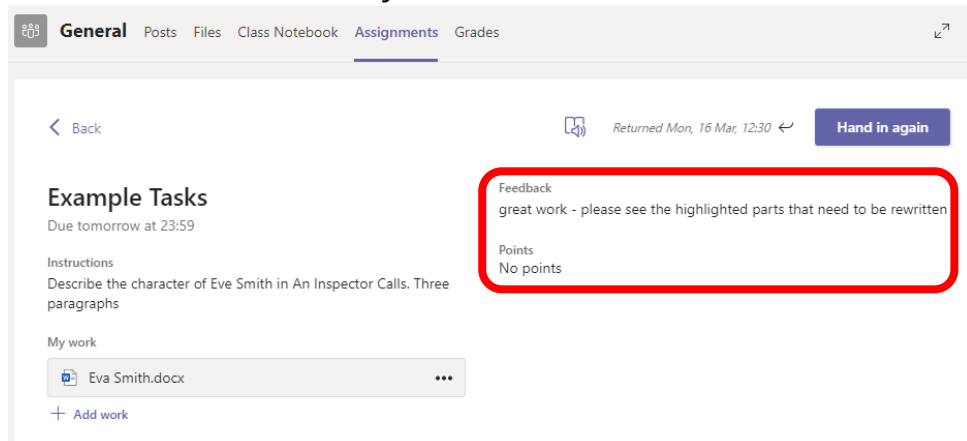
You can add a document that you have already been working on, or create a new one that you can do your work on. Follow your teacher's instructions.



Make sure that you have your work attached if required and click the **Hand In** button. Your teacher can now look at your work and give you feedback if required.



This piece of work has been looked at by this student's teacher and feedback has been given.



You can click on the file to open it and act on the feedback given to you by your teacher. You can also **+ Add work** to your submission. Once this is done you can then **Hand in again** by clicking the icon in the top right corner.
