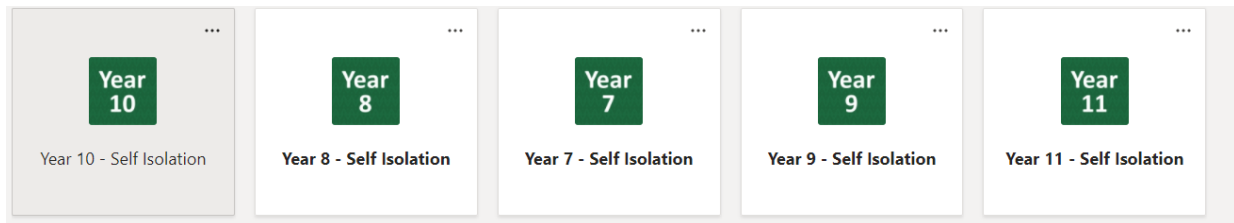


## LOCKDOWN INDEPENDENT REMOTE LEARNING – Years 7 – 10

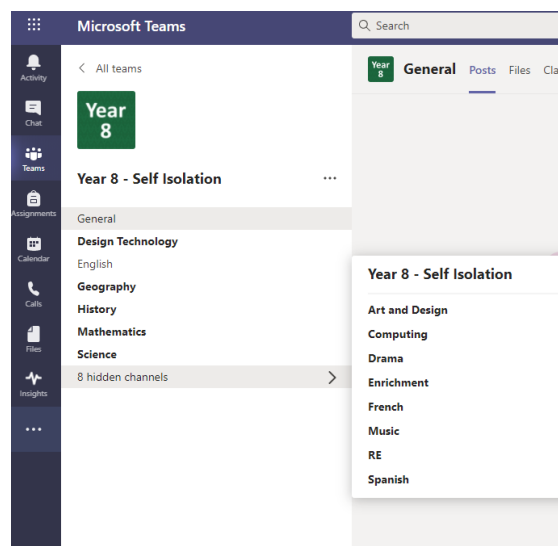

### GUIDANCE NOTES:

1. You are a member of a **whole year group Self Isolation Team**. This is a central area for all remote learning resources and instructions.



2. The year group **Self Isolation Team** has been divided into **subject channels** and this means you can access the work of any of your subjects / qualifications at any point. Some of the channels are classed as 'hidden' and can be unhidden by clicking on that menu option. See the Year 8 example below.



3. The work is found in the **Files section** at the top of each subject screen.
4. **Follow your timetable**, to stay organized. We would not expect you to work solidly for each double lesson so you not feel overwhelmed or disorganized
5. **Complete work on paper, in your exercise book** or on a device for online quizzes if you can.
6. **Send your completed work or a photograph of it** so teachers can check it.
7. Contact your friends first if you need help with something to do with the lesson, then email your teacher if you are still stuck.

## GENERAL ADVICE & TIPS FOR INDEPENDENT REMOTE LEARNING

Keep up a good routine for learning, for example:

- Get up, have breakfast and get dressed for the day ahead;
- Have a plan for the day, by following your timetable and work for at least one hour per subject;
- Work at a table or desk, not on your bed;
- Remember to move around regularly and take daily exercise if you can;
- Stay hydrated;
- Be in contact with friends;
- Talk to a parent/carer about what you are working on, if you can;
- Email a teacher if you have any specific questions. (Teachers will respond when they have the time).
