## Progress Scores

A score of 0 means pupils in a school on average do as well at KS2 as those with similar prior attainment nationally.

A positive score means pupils in a school on average do better at KS2 as those with similar prior attainment nationally.

A negative score means pupils in a school on average do not do as well at KS2 as those with similar prior attainment nationally.

A negative score does not mean that pupils did not make any progress however. Instead it means they made less progress than other pupils nationally with similar starting points.
