

16-19 Tuition Fund 2021-22

The 16-19 Tuition fund is additional funding for the academic years 2020 to 2021 and 2021 to 2022 for schools, colleges and other 16 to 19 institutions to mitigate the disruption to learning arising from coronavirus (COVID-19).

The funding is being provided to support small group tuition for 16-19 students in English, maths and other courses where learning has been disrupted.

Students eligible for this support

- The students supported need to be those who had not achieved grade 5 or above in English and/or maths by age 16.
- Have a grade 4 or above in English and/or maths, are from an economically disadvantaged background (defined as students from the 27% most economically deprived areas of the country based on the index of multiple deprivation) and are in need of catch-up support

How is Roundhay Sixth Form using this fund?

Roundhay is eligible to receive £3,166 of this fund. Examples of support offered may include GCSE exam resit preparation and bespoke subject/catch up in groups of up to 5 students (extended to 7 in exceptional circumstances). The support will take place in addition to the normal planned timetabled hours. Students with special educational needs and disabilities (SEND) and those classed as disadvantaged will be prioritised.
