

# CHILD DEVELOPMENT

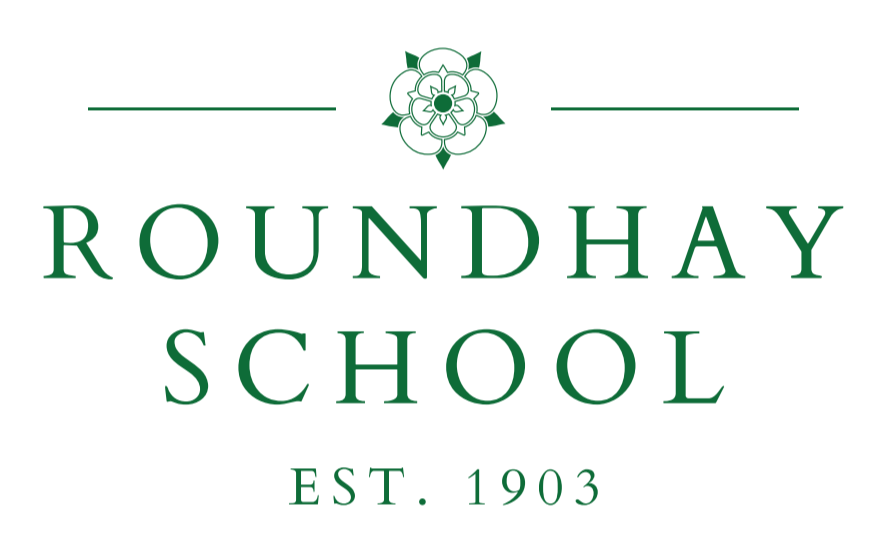
## Subject Vision

Our curriculum equips students with a thorough understanding of how a child develops from conception through to the age of 5. We also explore the reasons for having children and the factors that can affect a child's growth and development as well understanding the suitability of equipment and resources that support and nurture children.

### Aims:

- To develop core skills that enable learners to become independent, well rounded individuals, who can take an active role within society.
- To provide learners with an overview of the roles and responsibilities of parenthood alongside an understanding of reproduction and pre-conceptual, antenatal and postnatal care.
- Learners will develop an appreciation of the importance of creating the best conditions for a child to thrive. This includes creating a child-friendly home environment, including social safety and the care, management and prevention of childhood illnesses.
- Learners investigate the different equipment and nutritional requirements of children from birth to five years.
- Learners will be able to apply their knowledge and understanding, through a practical activity, to show how the needs are met to promote the well-being and development of the child.
- Learners will be able to investigate the developmental norms of children from birth to five years.
- Learners will develop an understanding of the impact of play on the developmental norms.
