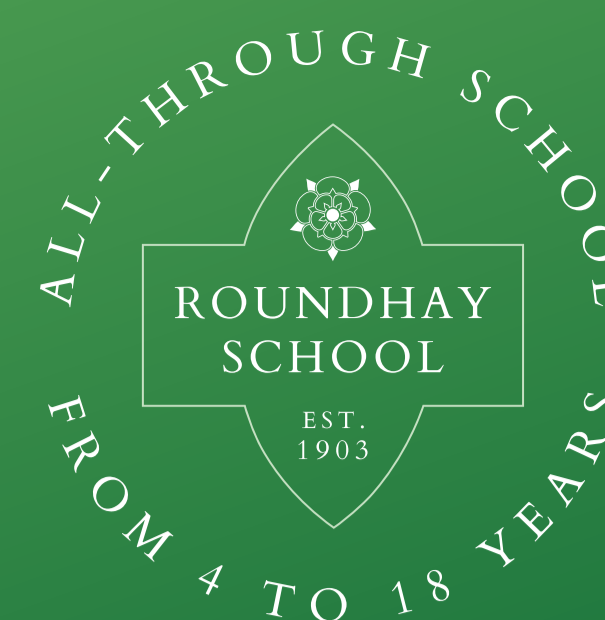


# STATISTICS
