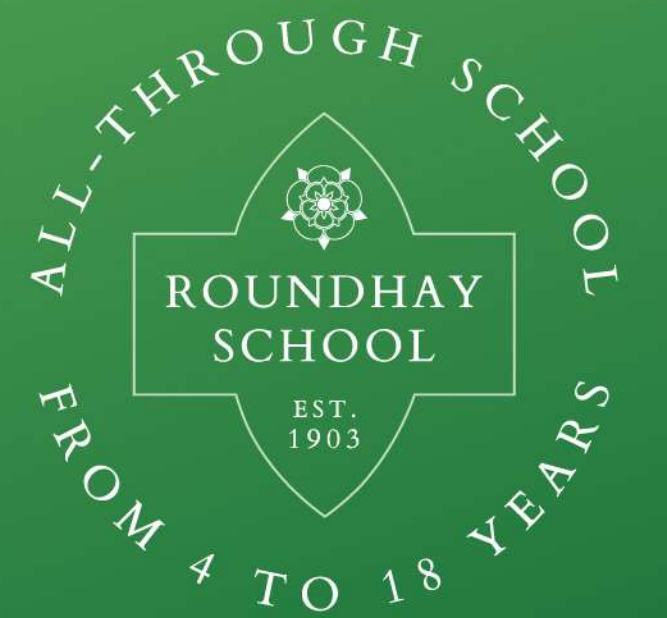


CEE JOURNEY
